We gathered each day to meet and began the time with prayer. The first day we listened to Amy Chan-McFrederick's song, *Gather the Wisdom*, and, indeed, we did just that as we tackled the tasks ahead. Our agenda was very full discussing some of the following agenda items:

- Preparation for the Elected Leaders Annual Assembly to be held October 27-30 at Weber Center in Adrian, Michigan
- Finances and the operation of DSC including exploration of alternate ways to set the dues schedule for congregational members of DSC
- Regional/Area Gatherings for 2013/2014
- Speaker for Leaders' Annual Assembly for 2014.

The Regional/Area Planning Committee met on June 25th via conference call. One of the items on the agenda was to put into words the theme for the gatherings. Update on Survey sent in April: 398 have now completed the survey with 18 of the 19 member congregations having one or more participants. One of the questions asked: *In your opinion, which of the following best expresses the purpose of the DSC?* The top three responses to that question were:

- DSC is a venue for networking with Dominicans across the country.
- DSC unites the sisters in their mission.
- DSC allows us to speak with one voice on justice issues

Another question asked: *In your opinion, which of the following express your greatest hope for DSC?* The responses in ranked order were:

- We might move towards Dominican Sisters USA
- We may find ways to share resources or create covenant relationship
- This could lead to international collaboration

Thank you to all who took the time to respond to the survey. It will help us to move forward.
