Sister Patricia Ann Reilly, OP of the Dominican Sisters, Sparkill, New York died on June 8, 2017 in Siena Hall, Sparkill, NY. Born in Bronx, NY, Genevieve Ann entered the Dominican Congregation of Our Lady of the Rosary in Sparkill on July 16, 1938 and received the name Sister Patricia Ann. She professed her first vows in 1940 and her final vows in 1945.

Sister Patricia Ann served in the Archdiocese of New York as a teacher in St. Agnes Home and School, Sparkill, NY (1940–1941). From 1941 to 1946 Sister Patricia Ann taught in St. Helena School then from 1946 to 1952 served as principal and teacher at Cardinal McCloskey in White Plains, NY. Sr. Patricia Ann went to Aquinas High School, Bronx, NY as a teacher from 1952 to 1954 then to St. Helena School, Bronx, NY from 1954 to 1969. Beginning in 1969 and for the next 30 years Sister was a professor and interim president at St. Thomas Aquinas College, Sparkill, NY before retiring to Dominican Convent.

Sister Patricia Ann Reilly was faithful to the God she loved and to the life she chose as a Dominican Sister. We will remember her for her generous spirit. We are grateful for her over seventy–eight years as a Sparkill Dominican and thank God for her life and her goodness. May the Lord shine His light upon her and give her eternal rest in the kingdom of heaven.
