

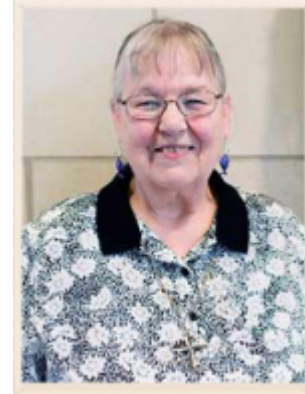

Professed in 1947, she taught in the following schools: Holy Rosary, Minneapolis; St. Patrick, Madison, WI; Incarnation, Minneapolis; Sacred Heart, Washington, DC; St. Cecilia, Omaha, NE; and Edgewood High School, Madison, WI.



Sr. Anne Marie served as principal at St. Anne, Wausau, WI, and as associate director for the Madison Diocese Office of Religious Education. She taught at Edgewood College, Madison, WI, and Santa Clara University, Santa Clara, CA, where she designed, directed, and taught in the graduate program in Pastoral Ministry. She ministered as director of the Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults at St. Patrick Parish, San Jose, CA. Sr. Anne Marie was a gifted writer, researcher, and catechist, publishing many articles and books. She ministered with U.S. bishops as one of the authors of the National Catechetical Directory; coauthored a series for children, *Living Waters*; and wrote several books, including *Signs of Catechesis*, *The Prophetic Spirit of Catechesis*, and *Trinity: A Story of Deep Delight* [to be published in 2018]. She recently celebrated 70 years of religious life. May she rest in peace.

Dominican Sister of Tacoma Joan Wales, OP (Sister Mary Harold)

Sister Joan Wales, OP (Sister Mary Harold), 87, died, peacefully on July 27 at St. Joseph's Residence in Seattle where she had resided for the last several years.

She was born in Seattle, Washington to Clara and Harold Wales, the second of four children. In 1937 the family moved to Ellensburg to run the Webster Hotel family business.

Sister Joan attended Lourdes Academy in Ellensburg, WA where she had the Tacoma Dominican Sisters as teachers. Her great aunt, Sister Mary Lourдина was also a Tacoma Dominican and was influential in her decision to enter the Dominican Community.

A funeral Mass at St. Joseph Residence was held on Tuesday, August 1. Sr. Joan had requested to be buried in Ellensburg, WA in the family plot. There will also be a Mass on Thursday, August 3, at 1:00 PM at St. Andrew Church followed by burial at Holy Cross Cemetery (both in Ellensburg).
