**Dominican Sister of Sinsinawa

Sister Margaret Muellenmeister, OP, died Nov. 14, 2017, at St. Dominic Villa. Her religious name was Sister Terza. The funeral Mass was held at the Dominican motherhouse, Sinsinawa, Nov. 17, 2017, followed by burial in the Motherhouse Cemetery.



Sister Margaret made her first religious profession as a Sinsinawa Dominican Sept. 12, 1946, and her final profession Sept. 12, 1949. She taught for 20 years and tutored for five years, served as culinary artist for eight years, and ministered as a parish visitor for 21 years and support staff for six years. Sister Margaret served in Minnesota, Illinois, Iowa, Wyoming, Wisconsin, New York, South Dakota, Oregon and Montana.
