Dominican Sister of Amityville Loretta Natoli, OP



On the morning of January 28, 2018, the God she loved and served called our dear Sister Loretta Natoli to her eternal rest. Loretta was 75 years old and had been a Dominican Sister for 56 years.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, on May 4, 1942, Loretta was the only child of John and Loretta Murphy Natoli. After graduation from St. Michael's High School, Loretta worked for a year before entering the Novitiate at Amityville on September 10, 1961. On August 6, 1962, she was clothed as a novice and given her religious name, Sister Melanie. She pronounced her first vows on August 7, 1963 and her final vows on August 7, 1966.

All services will be in St. Albert Chapel at Queen of the Rosary Motherhouse, Amityville, NY. The wake will take place on Tuesday, January 30, 2018 from 3 pm to 5 pm. Following Morning Prayer at 10:10 am on Wednesday, January 31, the Mass of Christian Burial will be celebrated at 10:30 a.m. Burial in the sisters' cemetery will follow immediately after Mass.

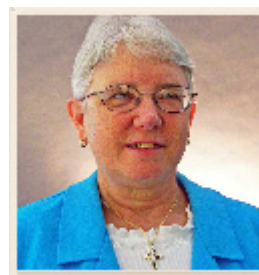
Dominican Sister of Racine Roserita Kimmel, OP
