Dominican Sister of Adrian Mary Diane McMeekin, OP

Sister Mary Diane McMeekin, the elder of two siblings was born on March 27, 1941 in Detroit, Michigan. She graduated from St. Joseph Academy in Adrian, Michigan. In 1959, she entered the Dominican Sisters of Adrian and at reception received the name Sister Robert Lorraine.



Diane ministered in elementary and kindergarten education for 27 ½ years. In 1989, she began a twenty-year ministry as the licensed Director of the Preschool and Nursery at Good Shepherd Church in Orlando, Florida, eventually accepting infants. The little children gave her energy, and she loved her interaction with the children and families. After she retired due to ill health, she began a ministry in “Prayer and Listening” to Seniors.

Sr. Kathleen served as principal at St. Pius, Chicago, and as pastoral associate at Christ the King Parish, Missoula, MT, and St. Dominic Parish, Denver, CO. She ministered as chaplain at All Saints Visiting Visiting Nurse Association, Racine, WI, where she also served with the hospice program; St. Joseph Hospital, Milwaukee; St. Luke Medical Center, Milwaukee; and Heartland Home Health Care and Hospice, Milwaukee, where she also served as bereavement coordinator. Sr. Kathleen provided family care in Milwaukee. May she rest in peace.
