Mary Louise Kerich was born in Minneapolis, Minnesota on September 30, 1924, the eldest of three children. She graduated from St. Joseph Academy in Adrian and entered the Congregation in 1941. At reception, she received the name S. Irene Marie.



Irene was a teacher; served in Congregational Leadership; was plant manager at Dominican High School and served as Pastoral Minister in Grosse Pointe Park, Michigan. After her parents' death, she assumed oversight responsibility for her younger brother, who was born with a disability. Although he was able to live on his own, Irene saw to his needs until he passed away. Despite the extra responsibility, her ministerial work continued. As Pastoral Minister, she worked with the poor and elderly. The people appreciated her kindness, thoughtfulness and joy. When she was physically unable to continue the pastoral work in 2003, she came to live at the Dominican Life Center where her graciousness continued.
