Dominican Sister of Amityville Helen Butler, OP

On Sunday morning of April 28, 2019, while the community was at the Divine Mercy Mass for the second Sunday of Easter, Sister Helen Butler died at 88 years old and had devoted 70 years to her Dominican Religious life to the Sisters of St. Dominic of Amityville.

She had varied ministries including the planning and creation of Dominican Village for the aging. Dominican Village in Amityville opened its doors in 1992 with Helen as President and CEO and is still in operation today. In 2002 Dominican Village received full accreditation in New York State by CARF for assisted living.
