Mary Schmagner, an only child, was born in Chicago on August 15, 1930. Her loving parents included her in their lives of assisting others in numerous ways. After graduation from high school, Mary entered the Adrian Dominican Sisters and took the name Sister John Elizabeth, to honor her parents. Mary's ministry was in education, pastoral ministry and counseling. Her parents' example formed Mary into the person she had become—generous, gracious, fun-loving and thoughtful. She had friends in abundance. In 2015, she became a resident of the Dominican Life Center (DLC). Although she had memory loss, she retained her delightful personality. Her health declined after she suffered a fall early in August. Mary died on August 12, 2019 at the DLC at the age of 88 and in the 70th year of her religious profession.
